A note from the Pastor

I don't know how to begin to talk about the last year without throwing out a bunch of clichés. "2020 will be a year we won't soon forget!" Or "No one prepared us for 2020." Maybe my favorite is, "Aren't you ready for 2021?!?"

But looking back on the past year, I think it's important to take survey of what we've done and what we need to do. First, I am thankful for the three months of online worship. Yes, I praise God for it. All of us lamented not meeting in person - online is just not the same. But for the time we were forced to worship remotely, First Baptist Church did just that - we worshiped.

Secondly, I am thankful for the people behind the scenes who worked extra hard to provide the best experience available. Becky and Tom Miller recorded worship music from their home. Jared Newnum has worked countless hours to make our livestream the highest quality. Gary and Loretta Gallion were our most faithful volunteers to clean and sanitize the church. There are many others who stepped up to serve as well, and for that I am beyond thankful.

Thirdly, God has taught us priorities. God used the shutdown to reveal to each person what they valued most. For many of you, weekly worship, whether online or in person, continued to be a weekly priority. For many others, our faith took a back seat to the other activities that we missed more. Many of you have shared your conviction on that issue. And I pray that many others will take inventory on what priorities they have in life.

Finally, God is calling us to move forward. It has been appropriate for us to pause in the midst of this pandemic. God has done so much through it. But many ministries that would normally have taken place were halted. They need to resume. That does NOT mean that we will be throwing caution to the wind. We still strongly encourage face coverings and social distancing when possible. But it does mean that we must not let a pandemic stop us from doing what God has called his church to do.

We must worship together. We must serve our community. We must disciple the people of First Baptist. We must be the church.

At some point, the time will come to "get back to normal." We're not fully there yet. But we are at a place where our "normal" must include ministry. I'm excited to see how God is going to use our growth in 2020 to serve Him in 2021.


