A note from the Pastor

The youth are the church of today. Our students have been growing spiritually and numerically through a tumultuous time in our world. This is not a result of human work, but the work of the Holy Spirit. Helping train, teach and mentor young people in the church is not a easy task. It's messy. It's costly. But it is necessary and has eternal significance.

In the book "Growing Godly Women" by Donna Greene she states "It takes a teenager an average of 2 years to deeply trust an adult. Most youth leaders or mentors get discouraged and give up after only 18 months. They never receive the benefits of deeply established love and trust." Working with young people requires patience, sacrifice and commitment. You can't expect instant results. In Greene's book she also states about teens" (they) want to feel secure—to know someone loves them. They want boundaries, rules and absolutes; but they will tolerate none of this without relationships. Teenagers recognize who loves them."

I can't say enough good things about the group of teens we have at our church right now. Are they perfect? No way! But are any of us? Are they growing? Yes! I'm excited about what God is doing at FBC, there is a fresh wind coming through and the youth are leading the way. Our theme verse for our student ministry is 1 Timothy 4:12 *"Let no one despise you for your youth, but set the believers an example in speech, in conduct, in love, in faith, in purity."*

Let us be people that recognize the value of our young people TODAY not for what they can contribute in the future. Involve them in the church body, they have so much to give!
