A note from the Pastor

Looking back, the theme of 2020 was probably "pandemic." Nothing prepared us for society's halt in the face of Covid-19. It really did reveal a lot about people and exposed our priorities and our fears. The theme for 2021 seemed to be "conflict." Our country was divided socially, politically, and morally. Our church certainly saw it's share of conflict. Count me among those who are ready to move past 2021. What then is our theme for 2022? Allow me to suggest several words.

Healing. What we need is recovery from the past two years. Time heals some wounds, but not all wounds. Some of our wounds require more than just the passing of time. This coming year can be a year that we slow down and seek God's plan of healing for our divided hearts.

Forgiveness. Healing won't take place without forgiveness. And I am confident that forgiveness will bring about healing. 1 John 1:9 says, "If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness." Healing comes from forgiveness. This year should see us focusing less about the past and more about how God will be moving in the future.

Empathy. This may be the hardest theme in the list. As conflict rages, it becomes more and more difficult to see a perspective different from your own. Conflict breeds pain - and there are a lot of people that you disagree with who are hurting. Galatians 6:2 commands us to "bear one another's burden." It doesn't say to "bear burdens you agree with." It says bear burdens. Period. This year can lead us to consider other's pain as our own and bear it together.

Unity/Family. Every brother and sister in Christ shares a common salvation and a familial bond. This is especially true for the brothers and sisters in Christ at a local church. We are a family. Not a distant, estranged family. We are the family of God. Being united and a family requires that we stick together regardless of the surrounding conflict. Those especially whom God has called to worship at FBC are our spiritual brothers and sisters. We share a bond with each other that is unique within the family of God. "So then, as we have opportunity, let us do good to everyone, and especially to those who are of the household of faith" (Galatians 6:10).

Perhaps there are better words we can use for a theme for this year. "Resolution", "faithfulness", or "truth" would all be wonderful options. Would you pray about what theme(s) God is calling you to focus on this coming year? And can you commit to Him to devote yourself to these principles?
