A note from the Pastor

Monsieur Charles Blondin is the most famous tightrope walker in history. On June 30, 1859, Blondin made the first of his 300+ trips across Niagara Falls. He never used a safety net, believing that preparing for doom almost certainly brough on doom. Eventually, he would cross the Falls in creative ways, including blindfolded, on stilts, and even carrying a small stove, pausing halfway across to cook an omelette.

On one of his trips, Blondin carried a wheelbarrow across the Falls. As the crowd cheered, he asked if they thought he could walk across with a man in the wheelbarrow. The crowd cheered with approval! Then Blondin asked for a volunteer...yet no one responded.

There is a fine line between faith and action. James 2 reminds us that faith without action is dead. Faith without works cannot save a person any more than works without faith. Many people express faith in certain contexts (in church, around Christian friends, etc) but their actions fail to show the faith that they profess. They are willing to trust the tightrope walker until it's time to get in the wheelbarrow!

What is it about your faith that requires action? The majority of Christians believe it's vital to share the gospel with friends and family. Yet the majority of Christians fail to act on that belief. Christians overwhelming believe the Bible is necessary to study and yet fail to read any outside of a church gathering. Forgiveness is required by Scripture and demanded by believers who have sinned, but it is often refused to those who sin against us.

The Christian life is not overly complicated. Jesus summed up the Christian responsibility in Matthew 22:37-39 by commanding us to love God fully and love our neighbor as ourselves. This requires us knowing God and His word. And it requires us investing in people with the gospel. As we reflect on the faith that we claim to have, I wonder if we can simply act on our convictions. It's time to turn our admiration of the tightrope walker into commitment to the wheelbarrow.




