A note from the Pastor

While the country is divided over how to interpret the reversal of Roe v Wade, it's important to think about what this means for Christians. How should we, as a church, be reacting to the Supreme Court decision in the Dobbs v Jackson case? Let me suggest three ways that we should be Biblically responding.

- 1. Rejoice! I have seen many Christians try to hedge their excitement over the reversal of Roe v Wade. I have to ask, why? For the first time in nearly 50 years, it is possible to fight against abortion rights. I realize that many people are mad and we risk offending them when we celebrate, but if we can't rejoice over the opportunity to save literally millions of babies, what can we celebrate? Be thankful of God's mercy through the decision of the court!
- 2. Pray. For roughly half of the states in our country, murdering babies became much harder if not practically impossible. But for many states, including our own state of Illinois, abortion rights may have actually become strengthened. Every state that Illinois borders is poised to have significant restrictions on abortions. But our state has pledged to expand abortion rights. California has advertised itself as a "destination" state for abortion. Major companies have pledged to pay all expenses for their employees seeking abortions. The battle for liberty has won, but the war for life is just beginning.
- 3. Serve. One of the major complaints from pro-abortion advocates is that Christians only care about babies that are unborn. While I have seen first hand that this stereotype is false, we as a church must do everything in our power to live out our Christian convictions for the unborn, the newly born, and the struggling mother/family. Our partnership with Christian pregnancy centers like Redeeming Love Ministry must grow stronger, financially and in service. Christian parents who have felt called to adopt but have hesitated must pray fervently and listen to God's call on their lives. Showing God's grace and redemption while we stand firmly on His Word are essential. We value all life, including, but not limited to, the unborn.

The battle for life is far from over. The reversal of Roe v Wade was a huge and historic step in the right direction. Now, we must continue the fight by rejoicing, praying, and serving.


