# A note from the Pastor

Thirty years ago this year, my life forever changed. On August 24, 1992, Hurricane Andrew blew through my hometown of Homestead, Florida. The house that my single mother had recently purchased was a total loss. The roof was completely gone. The ceiling lay on the floor of the house. My family was fortunate enough to be staying further inland or else we might have been one of the casualties reported.

As it was, the house we stayed in held together. Barely, I distinctly remember a crack below the roof line completely surrounding the house. The insurance adjuster said that a few more minutes of the storm, and the roof would have likely been peeled off. It too, would be unlivable for several months.

With both my mother and soon to be step-father without a house to live in, my sister and I were sent to Princeton, Kentucky to live with my grandmother. It was exciting and scary at the same time. I cannot imagine what was going through my mother's mind as she put us on a plane to leave for nine months. Though she would come up and visit as often as she could, we were not together as a family for the better part of a year.

In Kentucky, my sweet Christian Granny Bobby introduced me to church. Every Sunday, we attended. It wasn't just routine for her - it was a part of her life. Like breathing each minute or eating each day, we went to church because life depended on it. When I finally did get to come back to Florida, I craved that rhythm of church life. Shortly after moving home, I gave me life to Christ. The rest of my family did the same and we were baptized together, as a family.

The worst day of my life led to the best day of my life. Nearly losing my life led to me finding eternal life. The sacrifices forced upon my family led to us knowing the sacrifice of Jesus. No matter the circumstance, God is working our lives toward Him. Be thankful for the worst days because they often produce the best. Trust that God is using the disasters around you and the people who support you in those disasters to draw you to salvation and growth in Him.


