# A note from the Pastor

One of our microphones broke and needed to be replaced. It was sitting on the front pew when Josiah and I were working on some things. He came and hesitantly asked, "is it okay if I put things in that hole?" Something told me he knew he wasn't supposed to put things where he put them. He had shoved the broken microphone into a hole on the stage meant for chords. It was now lost to the abyss of under the stage. I assured him that it was fine because the mic was already broken. He was forgiven, but I stressed the importance of NOT putting items in the "hole" on the stage.

Fast forward a few days and we were working out a bug in the sound system. Josiah overheard me talking about the problem and solemnly said, "It's clogged. I clogged it." Poor guy thought that shoving the broken microphone into the stage had clogged up our sound system!

Too often, we let the grief of past sins haunt our present. Like Josiah, we hold on to our guilt and believe that, though forgiven, our sin is still causing our problems. And the truth is, our sin has consequences that often affect our circumstances. But it is just as true that we often are our own worst enemies when it comes to unforgiveness.

Romans 8:1 says "There is therefore now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus." Whatever sins you committed have no eternal effect on you. As a matter of fact, the writer of Hebrews says God will "be merciful toward their iniquities, and I will remember their sins no more" (Hebrews 8:12). While we feel the effects of a sinful, broken world in this life, we can have confidence that we are free from any guilt and condemnation in God's eternal Kingdom through Christ.
