A note from the Pastor

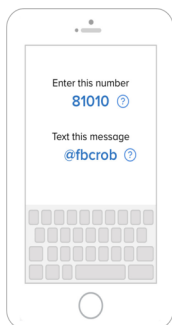
Summer time is so busy. What is advertised as a “break” from the rest of the year ends up being filled to the brim with ball games, activities, camps, and vacations. These are all good things! But they also have a tendency to dominate our time and energy. Unfortunately, that often shows up in our service to God. We are so tired from doing the things we want to do that we don't do the things we should do!

Is that really what our “break” does? Does our rest time actually make us more tired? God designed us to take breaks and have rest. He didn't create us to burn the candle at both ends. In His perfect design, God created us to sit back and relax.

That is why after six days of creating in Genesis 1 and 2, God **rested**. God also commanded the nation of Israel to work six days and **rest** on the seventh (Exodus 20:8-11). God even commanded that Israel let the land **rest** after six years of work (Leviticus 25:3-4)! In the New Testament, Jesus promises to give His people **rest** (Matthew 11:28).

The benefits of rest are numerous, but the most obvious reason we need rest is to be reminded of God's goodness to us and to trust in His promises to meet our needs. We need a day each week to be reminded that God is enough. We work diligently for six days and remember that God provides so much that we can just rest on day seven.

Since the New Testament times, Christians have taken their day of rest on “the Lord's Day” or “the first day of the week” in honor of the day Jesus was resurrected. It's time of worship and communion. But it's also a day of rest. This summer, do not neglect meeting together. You need the rest! And you need to remind yourself that Jesus meets your needs—you don't need the seventh day to yourself. You need that seventh day dedicated to Christ.

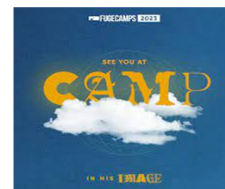
